

Natural Beauty

Throughout the Mexican territory and its coasts we find deserts, mangroves, mountains, tropical forests, marine sanctuaries and beaches. The great biodiversity of its scenery offers travelers a wide range of open-air activities with a high level of tourist infrastructure. National parks such as Zempoala and El Chico are ideal for camping, mountain biking and trekking. The Grutas de la Estrella in the State of Mexico and the submarine caverns of the Maya Riviera are explored in interesting tourist tours.

The Huasteca Potosina and its waterfalls, marine pools and rivers are scenarios for the adrenaline of rafting and rappel. And on hikes conducted by the local communities you can discover the secrets of natural reserves such as Los Tuxtlas, in Veracruz and Las Nubes, in Chiapas.

Semi-virgin beaches, dormant volcanoes, mystical deserts and coral reefs form part of this Mexican natural mosaic, as rich in variety as in travel experiences.



CLOSE TO HEAVEN

In the El Cielo Biosphere Reserve there is a tropical forest, a forest of pine and oak, as well as an arid plain in an unusual combination of flora and fauna that can be appreciated on conducted tours.

NATURAL KALEIDOSCOPE

In the Pantanos de Centla Biosphere Reserve you can see storks, herons, crocodiles and turtles. With over 500 flower species, it is the most important living museum for aquatic plants in Mesoamerica.

SANCTUARY IN THE SEA

The Sea of Cortés houses almost 40% of species of marine mammals that exist in the world and is the only place on the planet where there are submarine sand cascades.
